Excel Career: Randy attended Excel with his brother Kyle for several summers. A great basketball player who excelled in both sports in high school, Randy began his career as a walk-on collegiate basketball player at Santa Clara.

Career: Randy averaged 17 points per game and was a 3.6 gpa student at San Ramon where he played alongside another Excel Camper, Kevin Dunne. Randy played two years of college basketball at Santa Clara University before he was convinced by Coach Dick Davey to concentrate on baseball. Winn did get a chance to perform on an NBA court when his halfcourt shot during halftime of a San Diego Clippers game won him an automobile which he then gave to his mother. Randy played major league baseball for thirteen years including stints with the Tampa Bay Devil Rays, Seattle Mariners, San Francisco Giants, New York Yankees, St. Louis Cardinals and the Baltimore Orioles. He retired with a .284 lifetime batting average.
